Prescription Discount Cards Available

Dawn Archbold, Executive Director of the United Way of Lamoille County, wishes to remind people that FamilyWize prescription drug discount cards are available to help people with no prescription coverage lower the cost of their medicine. To date, \$2,000 has been saved by individuals in Lamoille County using these discount cards.

"Too many local families have insufficient or no prescription drug coverage at all," said Archbold. "Healthcare costs are one of the top concerns for people in our community, and the FamilyWize discount prescription drug cards will help families who otherwise could not afford much needed prescription drugs."

These cards, which can reduce prescription drug costs by an average of 20 percent or more, can be obtained from Central Vermont Community Action Council, Agency of Human Services, or the United Way of Lamoille County office. Kinney Drugs and Hannaford pharmacies are participating in this program and also have the cards available. People with Internet access can print a card by visiting the FamilyWize website at www.familywize.com as well as look up drug prices and the list of participating pharmacies. The cards have no usage limits, age requirements or registration forms.
